A student at Wilkes Academy will have an intensive timetable made up of lessons in a wide range of subjects including Ballet, Technical Jazz, Acting through Song, Commercial Dance, Ensemble Singing, Contemporary Dance, Tap and Contextual classes.

A wide range of assessment methods focus on authentic approaches to best prepare students for industry contexts. Students will be given opportunities to try out ideas, gain feedback and develop skills across performance disciplines. Assessment assists learning through both formative "interim" and summative "graded" assignments where students gain feedback and advice to carry forward into their personal practice.

Examples include:

- Creative outputs professionally presented in the format required by the brief, including performances, featuring full repertoire and showcase or revue material.
- Reflective journals, where you critically consider your own learning journey through the use of theoretical frameworks and commonly used methods of documentation (digital and written).
- Spoken presentations, project pitches, planning processes and industry-based research to support transferable skills development to best equip you for employability.

Predominantly, the Wilkes Academy Musical Theatre degree allows students to achieve their best, whilst encouraging independence, professional attitudes and industry readiness to equip students for their next steps.


